Construction Passes Halfway Point For New Ozone Treatment Facilities



One year in, construction on WaterOne's new Ozone Water Treatment Facilities is continuing on schedule. The project consists of a new facility, pipeline, and treatment equipment which are located at WaterOne's Hansen Treatment Plant on Holliday Drive. The project recently passed the halfway point, and the facility is on track to be complete by the summer of 2020.


The decision to utilize ozone in its treatment process is part of the district's forward-looking approach to infrastructure investment. Ozone is a powerful natural disinfectant and will offer enhanced treatment for bacteria, viruses, pharmaceuticals, and taste and odor compounds in the source water. Integrating ozone into the water treatment process will make WaterOne's operations

more efficient by eliminating, reducing, or simplifying water treatment chemicals and processes.

As of early March 2019, exterior work was largely complete on the main facility buildings. The extensive pipework required for the project is also nearing completion, including the installation of massive 108" buried ozone contact pipes. Liquid oxygen storage, vaporizers, and five ozone generators have been installed and most of the interior piping has been fitted. Work continues on systems and controls within the building, and the equipment testing phase will begin as construction finalizes. WaterOne expects to begin testing equipment in June, and will begin producing ozone for water treatment soon after. 💧


